
IN A DYNAMIC AND DIGITAL ENVIRONMENT, BUILDINGS WILL BE SMART AND ELECTRIC



Massive technological change (the digital age, digital transformation) is causing sweeping changes in our relationships with everyday objects.




ELECTRICITY AT THE HEART OF THE ENERGY ECOSYSTEM: BUILDINGS WILL PLAY A KEY ROLE

WHITE SAVING CERTIFICATES : EFFECTIVE BUT NOT ALWAYS EFFICIENT

What EDF does :

- National training scheme FEE Bat
- Information and mobilization
- Partnership with organizations such as Fondation Abbé Pierre (retrofit dwellings destined to very fuel poor populations)

What EDF learns :

- A stable number of retrofit operations
- Very few operations in the transport sector
- A cost allocation that could be better
